Bible Passage

Days 1-5: Fri 11 – Tue 15 September Alive Reading build up

Bible Passages

They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers...

...When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Acts 1:14 and 2:1-4

...God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and ... he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him. We are witnesses of everything he did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him on a cross, but God raised him from the dead on the third day and caused him to be seen...

Suggested Prayer Points

- The team and Reading churches to have expectancy for what God will do
- Good health for everyone involved
- For God to be at work now in the hearts of everyone who will hear the good news of Jesus during the mission

Bible Passages

(Peter said) 'Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah.'

... about three thousand were added to their number that day.

Paul's testimony

'On one of these journeys I was going to Damascus with the authority and commission of the chief priests. About noon ... as I was on the road, I saw a light from heaven, brighter than the sun, blazing around me and my companions. We all fell to the ground, and I heard a voice saying to me in Aramaic, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads."

'Then I asked, "Who are you, Lord?"

"I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting," the Lord replied.
